

**ORDER OF BEXAR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT SETTING THE
THE 2008 AD VALOREM TAX RATE AND LEVYING THE 2008 TAXES FOR THE
BEXAR COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT d/b/a UNIVERSITY HEALTH SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, The Bexar County Hospital District d/b/a University Health System (hereinafter the "District") recommended that Bexar County Commissioners Court set the tax rate for the District at the proposed tax rate of \$0.261022 per \$100 of taxable value; and

WHEREAS, Bexar County Commissioners Court, after notice published and posted as provided by law, held two public hearings on the proposed tax rate - one on August 28, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. and the second on September 2, 2008 at 9:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, after the public hearings, a Notice of Tax Revenue Increase of the District was published and posted as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2008, after due consideration of the District's recommendation, the Bexar County Commissioners Court voted to approve and adopt the 2008 proposed ad valorem tax rate recommendation of \$0.261022 per \$100 of taxable value which consists of two separate components, the Maintenance and Operation Tax Rate and the Debt Service Tax Rate; and

WHEREAS, at least four members of the Bexar County Commissioners Court are present to consider the adoption of the 2008 Maintenance and Operation Tax Rate for general support of the District; and

WHEREAS, at least four members of the Bexar County Commissioners Court are present to consider the adoption of the 2008 Debt Service Tax Rate for repayment of the principal and interest on the funded debt of the District; **NOW, THEREFORE**;

**BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS
COURT OF BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS:**

SECTION 1. That the 2008 proposed tax rate recommendation of \$0.261022 per \$100 taxable value is hereby adopted, in two separate components, and approved as follows:

- a. Maintenance and Operation Tax Rate of \$0.235234 is hereby levied, and shall be assessed and collected on each \$100 assessed valuation of all taxable property situated in Bexar County, Texas.
- b. Debt Service Tax Rate of \$0.025788 is hereby levied, and shall be assessed and collected on each \$100 assessed valuation of all taxable property situated in Bexar County, Texas to ensure payment of principal and interest on Certificates of Obligation issued by Bexar County Commissioners Court in the name of and for the benefit of the District and primarily on the faith and credit of the District and to create a sinking fund for the payment thereof.

SECTION 2. The tax rate shall not be applied to property exempt from hospital district taxation by the laws of the State of Texas or by the Bexar County Commissioners Court as authorized by the laws of the State of Texas.

SECTION 3. In accordance with the provisions and requirements of Section 26.05 of the Texas Tax Code, as amended, the Bexar County Commissioners Court hereby states that THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

SECTION 4. The Bexar County Commissioners Court further states that THE TAX RATE WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$-2.18.


