Alexander E. Briseño was nominated to the Bexar County Hospital District's Board of Managers by Bexar County Judge Nelson Wolff in 2001. He serves on the board's Budget & Finance Committee.

A graduate from Central Catholic High School in San Antonio, he received a bachelor's degree in economics and a master's degree in urban studies from Trinity University.

Briseño retired as San Antonio City Manager in 2001, after nearly 11 years in the top administrative position and 24 total years with the city. Prior to joining city government, Briseño earned the rank of Captain in the U.S. Army. In addition to his service on the Health System Board of Managers, Briseño is also chairman of the Board of Trustees for the San Antonio Water System (SAWS).

Following his retirement, Briseño was appointed Professor of Public Service in Residence at St. Mary's University where he teaches graduate courses in Public Administration. In addition, he frequently addresses participants in public and private sector professional development seminars and provides municipal consulting services. In recent years, Briseño has also been called upon to serve short-term appointments as Interim President of the San Antonio Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, Interim President/CEO of the San Antonio Water System, Interim President/CEO of the San Antonio Technology Accelerator Initiative (SATAI) Network, and Interim Executive Director of the Brooks Development Authority.

He is a Fellow of the National Academy of Public Administration and a member of the International City/County Management Association, the Texas City Management Association and the American Society for Public Administration. He also serves on the Trinity University Board of Visitors.
