Cedillo is currently President of Strategic Initiatives, a firm that provides strategic planning, organizational and policy development, and management services to businesses and public agencies.

Cedillo served as chair of the Intergovernmental Affairs Division of the American Planning Association and a member of the Water Resources Council of the American Water Works Association and the Urban Land Institute.

She is currently on several civic boards, and an appointee on several city and county task forces related to public policy, strategic planning, natural resource and urban planning issues. She was a member of United Way of San Antonio Board of Directors, the San Fernando Cathedral Community Centre business affairs and strategic planning committees and Leadership Texas.
