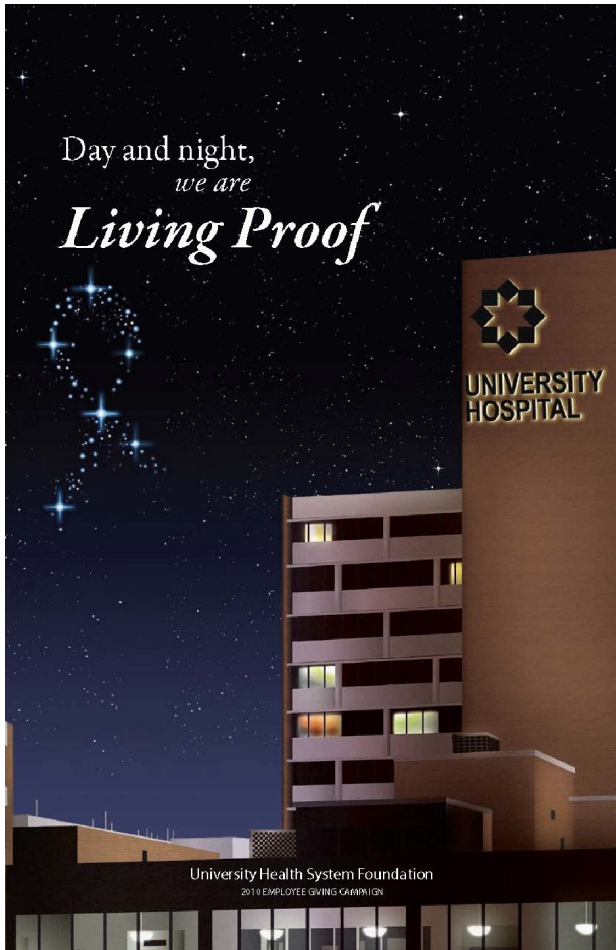


2010 Employee Giving Campaign Huge Success



With over 1,477 University Health System staff participating, this year's Employee Giving Campaign raised \$124,579.67!

The average gift per person was \$84.34 – a 2.23% increase over last year's donations. Fifty staff members participated as Foundation Ambassadors and presented the campaign to over 5,000 staff members. "Our Ambassadors are the reason for this campaign's success – they brought a lot of energy and enthusiasm for the various funds the Foundation supports," said Denise Pruett, UHS Foundation Director.
