

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.276235 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of BEXAR COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT DBA UNIVERSITY HEALTH.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.276235 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.249769 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.294091 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2022 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for BEXAR COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT DBA UNIVERSITY HEALTH from the same properties in both the 2021 tax year and the 2022 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that BEXAR COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT DBA UNIVERSITY HEALTH may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that BEXAR COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT DBA UNIVERSITY HEALTH is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2022 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 6, 2022 AT 9:35 A.M. AT DOUBLE-HEIGHT COURTROOM SECOND FLOOR BEXAR COUNTY COURTHOUSE 100 DOLOROSA SUITE 2.01 SAN ANTONIO TEXAS 78205-3038.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, BEXAR COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT DBA UNIVERSITY HEALTH is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the BEXAR COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT DBA UNIVERSITY HEALTH at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

No-New-Revenue Maintenance and Operations Rate Adjustments

Indigent Health Care Compensation Expenditures

The BEXAR COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT DBA UNIVERSITY HEALTH spent \$347,830,358 from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 on indigent health care compensation expenditures at the increased minimum eligibility standards, less the amount of state assistance. For the current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's enhanced indigent health care expenditures is \$30,769,699. This increased the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate by \$0.014282/\$100.
