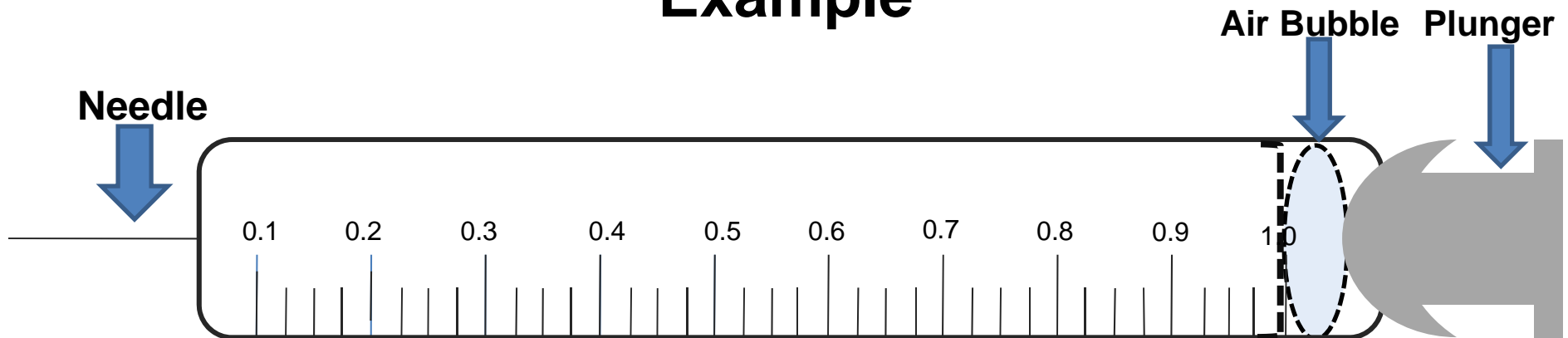

2. *Very slowly* squirt out the extra medication using the plunger until the bottom of the air bubble is at _____.
3. Leave the air bubble in the syringe.
4. Inject dose as directed by your doctor.

- 0.1 = 10mg
- 0.2 = 20mg
- 0.3 = 30mg
- 0.4 = 40mg
- 0.5 = 50mg
- 0.6 = 60mg
- 0.7 = 70mg
