Training Descriptions

Introduction to Trauma-Informed Care (1 Hr)

In this course, attendees will receive an overview of key elements to help build their foundation of trauma-informed care. This includes an introduction to Adverse Childhood Experiences, the impact of trauma, and trauma-informed care. This session will also highlight how the Institute can help organizations on their journey towards trauma-informed certification.

Implementing Trauma-Informed Care Principles (1 Hr)

In this course, attendees will receive an overview of the impact of trauma and an introduction to the six key principles of a trauma-informed approach. The information in this course will serve as building blocks to help you on your trauma-informed journey. The presentation is derived from *Basics of ACEs, trauma, building resilience and using a Trauma Informed Approach* training by international author and speaker, Becky Haas.

ACE Interface Training (1.5 Hrs)

In this course, attendees will learn about the Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE) study, along with neurology that explains why ACEs have an immense effect on people's lives, and what we can all do to dramatically improve health and resilience for this and future generations. Trainings are conducted by a Master ACE Trainer.

Secondary Traumatic Stress

In this Course, attendees will take part in an in-depth discussion on secondary traumatic stress and its effects on front-line workers, managers of service organizations and schools. Learners will also participate in activities that promote awareness and resilience from secondary trauma. This session is led by Tyler Radwin, outreach coordinator at ChildSafe.
